Beryl desató toda su furia

Con sus fuertes vientos y lluvias dejó muertos y a millones sin luz

Matagorda, Texas — El huracán Beryl azotó Texas la madrugada del lunes con intensas lluvias y fuertes vientos, dejando sin electricidad a 2 millones de hogares y negocios e inundando calles.

Beryl dejó un rastro de destrucción letal por partes de México y el Caribe antes de girar hacia Texas. El huracán de categoría 1 tocó tierra poco antes de las 4 de la madrugada y luego se debilitó hasta convertirse en tormenta tropical unas cinco horas después. Se reportaron al menos dos muertes.

Las calles rápidamente comenzaron a inundarse en Houston, la cuarta ciudad más grande del país, que volvía a estar bajo alertas de inundación después de fuertes tormentas en los últimos meses que anegaron vecindarios y provocaron apagones.

CenterPoint Energy en Houston reportó que 2 millones de hogares y negocios se quedaron sin electricidad horas después que la tormenta tocara tierra.

Dos personas murieron después de que árboles cayeron sobre sus casas: un hombre en el suburbio de Humble en Houston y una mujer en el condado Harris, dijeron las autoridades. Cientos de árboles cayeron en el condado, aplastando vehículos y dañando casas, indicó el oficial Mark Herman, del condado Constable.

Beryl se había debilitado a tormenta tropical tras causar daños a su paso por la península de Yucatán, en México, pero se convirtió en huracán de nuevo la noche del domingo. El centro de la tormenta tocó tierra de nuevo a unos 137 kilómetros (85 millas) al suroeste de Houston, con vientos máximos sostenidos de 128.7 km/h (80 mph).

Más de 1,000 vuelos fueron cancelados el lunes en los dos aeropuertos de Houston, según datos de vuelos de FlightAware.

Beryl, la tormenta que más temprano ha alcanzado la categoría 5 en una temporada del Atlántico, provocó al menos 11 muertes a lo largo de su paso por el Caribe rumbo a Texas. El meteoro arrancó puertas, ventanas y techos con vientos devastadores y marejadas azuzadas por una temperatura récord en las aguas del océano.

Tres veces en su semana de vida, Beryl ha ganado 56 km/h (35 mph) de velocidad del viento en 24 horas o menos, la definición oficial

de intensificación rápida del servicio meteorológico.

El crecimiento explosivo de Beryl hasta convertirse en una tormenta temprana sin precedentes es un reflejo de las altas temperaturas del agua en el Atlántico y el Caribe, y lo que el cinturón de huracanes del Atlántico puede esperar durante el resto de la temporada de tormentas, dijeron los expertos.

Ante el aviso de la llegada de Beryl, la gente en la zona costera de Texas cubrió ventanas con tablo-

nes y se alejó de los poblados plajeros bajo órdenes de evacuación. A lo largo de la costa de Texas, muchos residentes y propietarios de negocios tomaron las precauciones usuales para tormentas, aunque también expresaron reparos sobre su intensidad.

En la localidad de Port Lavaca, Jimmy May instalaba madera contrachapada sobre las ventanas de su compañía de suministro eléctrico y dijo no estar preocupado por la posible marejada generada por la tormenta. Recordó que su negocio no se había inundado durante el paso de un huracán previo que trajo consigo una marejada de 6 metros (20 pies).

“En el pueblo, si uno está en las áreas bajas, obviamente necesita irse de allí”, señaló.

La Casa Blanca dijo el domingo que la Agencia Federal para el Manejo de Emergencias (FEMA) envió socorristas, equipos de búsqueda y rescate, agua embotellada y otros recursos a Texas.

Un hombre murió en el suburbio de Humble, en Houston, cuando un árbol cayó sobre una casa, atrapándolo bajo los escombros, según el jefe policial adjunto del condado Harris, Thomas M. Gilliland.

La semana pasada, Beryl azotó México como huracán de categoría 2, derribando árboles pero sin dejar muertos ni heridos, y luego se debilitó a tormenta tropical a su paso por la Península de Yucatán.

Antes de llegar a México, Beryl causó destrucción en Granada, Jamaica, San Vicente y las Granadinas, Barbados y Venezuela. Se reportó sobre la muerte de tres personas en Granada, tres en San Vicente y las Granadinas, tres en Venezuela y dos en Jamaica.

Reportan ataques de tiburón

South Padre Island, Texas — Las celebraciones del Cuatro de Julio en South Padre Island se vieron interrumpidas luego de que dos personas fueron atacadas por un tiburón el jueves y llevadas a un hospital, al menos una de ellas con mordeduras graves, informaron las autoridades.

La policía fue llamada después de que un hombre fue mordido gravemente alrededor de las 11 a.m., de acuerdo con Nikki Soto, secretaria municipal de South Padre Island.

Inicialmente fue atendido en la playa por bomberos y oficiales de policía.

El Departamento de Parques y Vida Silvestre de Texas posteriormente dijo en un comunicado que dos personas fueron mordidas y otras dos “tuvieron un encuentro” con un ti-

burón, pero no sufrieron heridas de consideración.

Una de las personas mordidas fue trasladada a un hospital en Brownsville y la otra “transportada por aire a recibir más tratamiento”.

Con base en reportes de testigos e imágenes en medios sociales, las autoridades creen que un solo tiburón de unos 6 pies de longitud (1.8 metros) fue el animal atacante, dijo el guarda de fauna capitán Chris Dowdy.

Luego del incidente, elementos de la patrulla de playa, bomberos y policías estuvieron patrullando la playa y volando drones, dijo Soto.

El último ataque de tiburón que se había registrado en la zona tuvo lugar hace cinco años, dijo Dowdy.

El Departamento de Parques y Vida Silvestre está apoyando en la investigación.

Regresa el Polvo del Sahara

El polvo del Sahara ha hecho otro viaje a través del Atlántico y estamos viendo sus efectos esta semana en Texas, según funcionarios meteorológicos.

La capa de aire del Sahara es una masa de aire seco y polvoriento que se forma sobre el desierto del Sahara a finales de la primavera, el verano y principios del otoño, según la Administración Nacional Oceánica y Atmosférica (NOAA). Los vientos transportan esta masa miles de kilómetros a través del Atlántico y ocasionalmente llega a Texas.

Este polvo puede tener varios efectos, como cielos brumosos, amaneceres y atardeceres coloridos, pero también una reducción en la calidad del aire. El polvo puede ser especialmente perjudicial para la salud de niños, adultos mayores y personas con problemas cardíacos o pulmonares.

A partir de la semana pasada, el polvo ha estado más concentrado en la región de Brownsville, pero buena parte de la costa de Texas experimentó un aumento en la capa de aire sahariana, explicó Monte Oaks, meteorólogo del Servicio Meteorológico Nacional en New Braunfels. El NWS informó de una “neblina generalizada” en Corpus Christi el lunes pasado por la mañana que probablemente se debía al polvo.

Los funcionarios meteorológicos del NWS en Fort Worth, sin embargo, dijeron que no se ha visto mucho en el radar en términos de polvo. Se espera que la mayor parte del polvo pase hacia el oeste de Dallas-Forth Worth, aunque igual existe la posibilidad de que el área experi-

mente algunos efectos. “Hay una cantidad considerable que... si se concentrara en el área de Dallas, podría ser más prominente mañana y luego disminuir nuevamente”, dijo Oaks. “Así que sólo un día en el que es posible que haya algo de neblina”.

Texas Rangers y MLB develan colorido mural en Fort Worth

Fort Worth — Cuando era niño, Juan Velázquez soñaba con ser artista, aun cuando otros le decían que no lo lograría.

Por años, Velázquez encontró otras formas de ganarse la vida, como un empleo en telecomunicaciones y una temporada en el ejército.

Hace cuatro años, despedido a causa de la pandemia, decidió dedicarse al arte que le apasiona.

De 35 años, Velázquez develó su más reciente creación el miércoles en Fort Worth, rodeado por líderes de la comunidad latina y docenas de niños en edad escolar.

El mural, un homenaje a los jugadores y jugadoras de beisbol latinos por encargo de los Texas Rangers y la MLB, es para motivar e inspirar a los niños y adultos por igual.

“Esto es para todos aquellos que creen en sí mismos, los que tienen un sueño”, dijo Velázquez. “Luchen por él; la vida es corta”.

La develación del mural fue uno de varios eventos comunitarios planeados con motivo del juego All-Star a disputarse en el Globe Life Field de Arlington.

La obra de arte se extiende sobre un muro exterior del Artes de la Rosa Cultural Center, a pocos minutos de Fort Worth Stockyards.

La superficie alguna vez blanca ahora desborda de colores azul cielo y verde pasto, visible desde North Main Street.

La ilustración pintada con spray describe el desarrollo de los jugadores, desde niños, jugando T-ball, hasta convertirse en profesionales de grandes ligas.

Una niña abanica el bate. Cerca, un niño con gorra de los Texas Rangers y un guante de beisbol mira a la distancia, soñando despierto.

Estrellas latinas del beisbol como

Yovani Gallardo aparecen cerca de una representación del perfil de Fort Worth y sobre fondo de estadio.

Gallardo, oriundo de Fort Worth, dijo que era “un honor y privilegio” aparecer en el mural.

Dijo que, como Velázquez, de niño varias veces le dijeron que nunca llegaría a ser beisbolista profesional.

“Todo es posible si uno pone toda su mente y empeño en ello”, dijo Gallardo a los asistentes.

Los latinos han jugado un papel preponderante en la MLB, uno de los deportes profesionales más diversos.

Unos 2,000 jugadores de origen hispano han figurado en el roster de equipos de grandes ligas, de acuerdo con la MLB.

Actualmente alrededor del 30% del talento de la liga es latino, y el porcentaje sigue creciendo cada temporada.

Los Rangers son socios de Artes de la Rosa Cultural Center, fundado en el año 2000 para preservar, proteger y promover la obra de artistas latinos del Norte de Texas.

Es el único centro cultural latino en Fort Worth y el condado de Tarrant.

Catalina Villegas, directora de diversidad, equidad e inclusión de la MLB, dijo que lo que se busca con el mural es inspirar la inclusión y la representación

William Girón, director ejecutivo del centro, dijo que la obra es “un gran ejemplo de diversidad, equidad e inclusión en esta gran ciudad”.

Velázquez ha pintado más de 150 murales en la región.

Muchos de ellos representan figuras locales y del Centro de Texas como Willie Nelson en Hillsboro.

Uno de los murales más populares de Velázquez describe al exjardinero de los Rangers Rougheed Odor asestando un golpe en la cara al ahora retirado All-Star de los Blue Jays José Bautista.

El mural en Arlington se basa en una trifulca entre los dos jugadores en la única casa de los Rangers, el

Globe Life Park, en 2016. Ray Casas, director de impacto comunitario de los Rangers y originario de Fort Worth, dijo que el últi-

mo mural de Velázquez es más que una obra de arte. “Es un espejo para que se miren los niños del barrio y se vean repre-

sentados, porque la representación es importante”, dijo Casas. “El acceso es importante y la oportunidad es importante”.

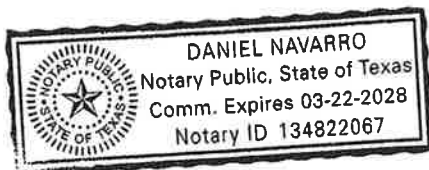
