**Section 3.6 Public Opening:**

The public opening for this RFP will be conducted at approximately 2:05 p.m. CT on April 7, 2021.

The meeting will be held digitally via Microsoft Teams, and will be recorded for the RFP file. Please be advised that a large volume of proposals will result in delays in the decryption process.

Access information and the meeting invite will be posted to Public Purchase on the week of April 5, 2021.

**Section 6.04 Insurance Requirements:**

At all times during the term of a contract resulting from this procurement, the contractor shall procure, pay for, and maintain, with approved insurance carriers, the minimum insurance requirements set forth below, and shall require all contractors and sub-contractors performing work for which the same liabilities may apply under this contract to do likewise. The contractor may cause the insurance to be affected in whole or in part by the sub-contractors or sub-subcontractors under their contracts. NCTCOG reserves the right to waive or modify insurance requirements at its sole discretion.

### **Question #1**

On the specifications, for Items #5, #6 & #8 there is no information provided on requirements for: Figure of Merit, Signal to Noise & Resolution. Please advise.

**Answer #1: The following specifications are derived from manufacturer datasheets, U.S. Department of Defense publications, and from authorized third-party resellers when data is otherwise not readily available.**

**Item 5 AN/PVS-31A (BNVD): FOM 2376 (min) SNR: 25.0 (min) Resolution: 64 lp/mm**

**Item 6 AN/PVS-24 (CNVD): FOM: 1344 (min) SNR: 21:1 (min) Resolution: 64 lp/mm**

**Item 8 AN/PVS-14 MNVD White Phosphor: FOM 2376 (min) SNR: 36 min. Resolution: 64 lp/mm**

## **Question #2**

Is there a Warranty specified for all systems? Please advise.

**Answer #2: Vendors are asked in Section 7: How to Submit Your Proposal, Tab D: Technical Proposal #4 to provide a description of their customer satisfaction services, to include any warranty and/or repair capabilities.**

## **Question #3**

For all items, please advise if they are to be thin filmed or filmless phosphor technology image intensifier tubes.

**Answer #3. Please see the response below:**

**For Items 9-24, if you can provide thin filmed and filmless phosphor technology image intensifier tubes, then please indicate as such in your response. If you can provide both, please indicate. List the specific percentage discount for each.**

## **Question #4**

For all items, there is no reference to Mounting Configurations and/or Specific Accessory Items that are to be included in the Systems Offering. Please advise.

**Answer #4: SHARE recognizes that there are multiple variants of each item that are manufactured by numerous firms. Each vendor's item offering per system may differ. As such, SHARE does not intend to designate specific accessory items that are to be included in systems offering. Regarding specifications for the mounting configurations for each item, Vendors are asked to provide their mounting options that are compatible with the model the vendor is proposing.**

## **Question #5**

Is it required for vendors to bid on every item listed in the Market Basket?

**Answer #5: Responses are encouraged from vendors who can only provide a handful of items. Respondents are not expected to be able to provide the entirety of the desired goods, though are welcome to if they are able!**

**Vendors may propose any combination of categories. Respondent should answer all questions related to each item on which Respondent wishes to propose, and either leave the questions for other items unanswered (blank) or indicate "No Bid."**

**Question #6**

Is this a single or multiple award contract?

**Answer #6: SHARE may award contracts to multiple Respondents supplying comparable products or services, also known as a multiple award schedule, or award the contract to a single Respondent.**

**SHARE's decision to make multiple awards or a single award will be based upon its sole discretion regarding the type of award that provides best value.**

**Question #7**

How long is the term of the contract?

**Answer #7: The initial term for a contract(s) resulting from this RFP will be two (2) years. SHARE will have the option to extend the contract for up to three (3) additional one (1) year terms. The total term of the Master Contract shall not exceed five (5) years.**

**Question #8**

What are the potential annual quantities for this "Catalogue-Type" Pricing during this Contractual Period?

**Answer #8: Be advised that this project is being solicited with the intent of being made available as a cooperative contract. Also known as an interlocal contract, any agreements retained under this project are intended to be accessible for use by any public sector agency, municipal and local government, etc.**

**These agencies could access an awarded vendor's services under this project without having to perform a procurement project of their own. Awarded vendors would have the freedom to approach public sector entities and notify them that their Night Vision product offering could be had without requiring a potential client to perform an RFP of their own.**

**As such, SHARE would not be able to estimate annual quantities . Individual SHARE members utilizing the contract will have their own budgets and night vision needs. The potential business opportunities for an awarded vendor are limited only by their own outreach and marketing capabilities.**

**Question #9**

Can you direct us to where we might find the specific insurance requirements for the State of Texas?

**Question #10**

Is there an overarching delivery requirement in days? Or will each order specify the customer's delivery day requirement?

**Answer #10:** Delivery may be by common carrier, postal service, or other private delivery service. Delivery must occur within 5 – 7 business days after receipt of order, except in cases of backordered or items that must be assembled to client's need.

**If the indicated date cannot be met, the proposer shall state its best delivery time.**

**Question #11**

If an item is quoted in the market basket; does that item also need to be included in the proposed catalog?

**Answer #11:** Yes, Respondents are asked to complete and submit their Pricing Proposal, in addition to their Catalog or Pricelist. The market basket is a value exercise, while the proposed catalog is an actual record of prices proposed.

**The market basket will not populate the Catalog or Pricelist or vice versa.**

**Question #12**

Will there be evaluation point deductions for no bidding any line items listed in the Market Basket?

**Answer #12:** SHARE will not deduct points for no bidding any line items listed in the RFP 2021-007 Market Basket.

**Question #13**

**Answer #13:** SHARE is a National Public Sector cooperative purchasing program which allows any public entity or non-profit use of a SHARE contract and its selected vendor(s) and pricing to pursue their own projects. ## **ATTACHMENT IV: RESTRICTIONS ON LOBBYING**
