



- Regularly-schedule site visits made during defined months to assess current pond conditions, apply scheduled treatments, and/or perform submergent vegetation detection.
- Proactive, scheduled algaecide application will be performed to control algae such as planktonic, filamentous, bluegreens and chara.
- Proactive, scheduled aquatic herbicide application will be performed to control submergent macrophytes (all plants not including algae) such as bushy pondweed, coontail, hydrilla and American floating pondweed.
